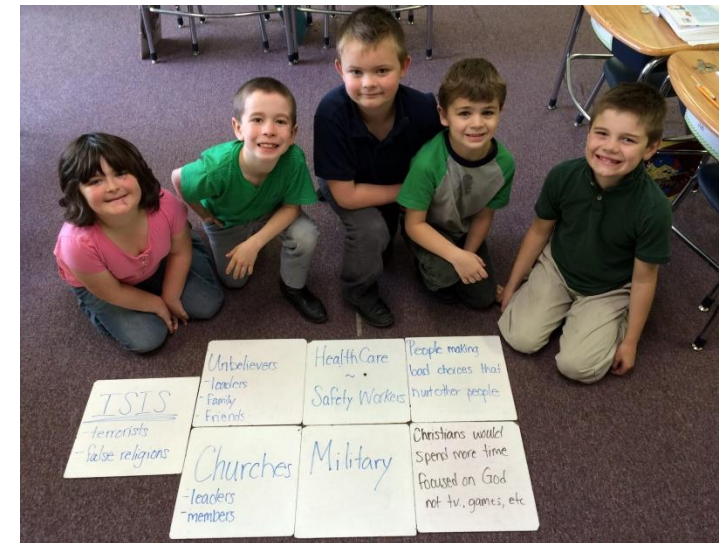

Re-enrollment

Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an online application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment by **June 1, 2016**. Applicants **must** apply online at <https://online.factsmtg.com/signin/3M9XJ> and search for VHCA using our zip code 13815.

A nonrefundable \$30 application fee must be received by FACTS in order to process your application.
