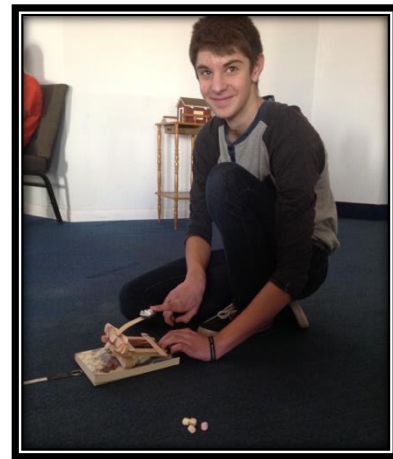
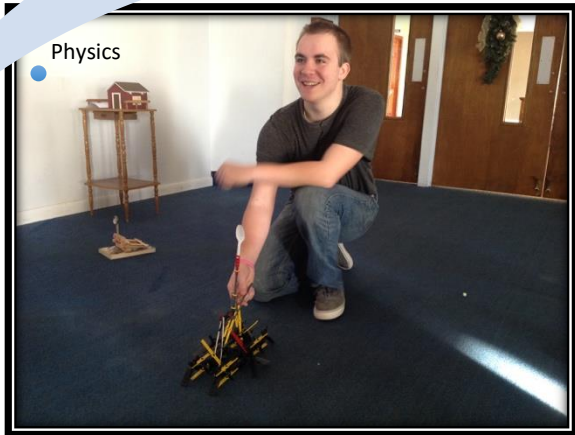
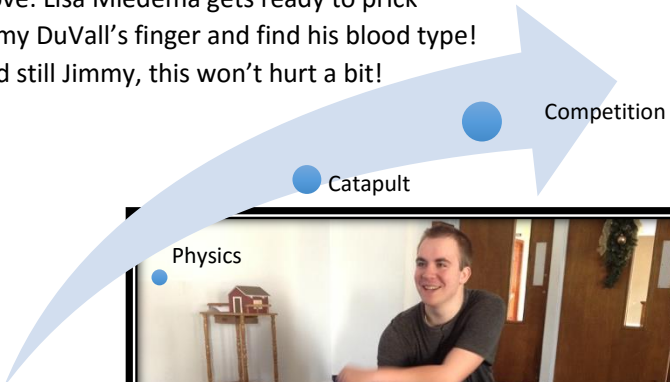

Above: Lisa Miedema gets ready to prick Jimmy DuVall's finger and find his blood type! Hold still Jimmy, this won't hurt a bit!

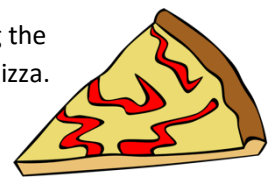
